What to expect at the October 18th outdoor worship service:

- The service will begin at 8:30 AM, please dress for the weather.
- Those who have difficulty with ambulation may park in the parsonage driveway.
- Masks will be required. Please bring your own, but we will have extras.
- Ushers will wear masks and face shields and will be there to assist you. We ask that you respect and follow the ushers' directions, both in seating and during dismissal.
- Please bring your own chair. If you cannot, we will have chairs available.
- Chair locations will be predetermined and marked for maximum social distancing. We ask that the spacing between chairs be maintained throughout the service, even between members of the same household.
- Please do not congregate or socialize prior to being seated or after being dismissed.
- The service will be thirty minutes long.
- There will be no singing and no prayers spoken by the congregation, except for brief responses in the liturgy.
- All aspects of the service will be "contact-free."
- There will be a plate available for offering as you enter, ushers will not pass the plate.
- There will be no printed material whatsoever. We will email the Outdoor Order of Worship with the Invitation to 10:00 AM Zoom worship. Though there will be no need for a bulletin during the outdoor service, you may print one at home and bring it if you like.
- Communion will be offered toward the end of worship. You may pick up a pre-filled and sealed communion cup with a wafer in the lid as you enter the service. If you are not comfortable taking communion during worship, ushers will direct you so that you may exit during the musical interlude prior to communion, to take communion at home.

We are looking forward to coming together both in person and in spirit!

IF you are feeling ill or experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, do not to attend in-person worship. If you are in a category at higher risk for COVID-19, we encourage you not to attend in-person worship. If you have visited a high-risk area as designated by the State of New York, do not attend in-person worship. *Anyone in these categories is encouraged and welcomed to attend our 10 AM Zoom Worship.*
